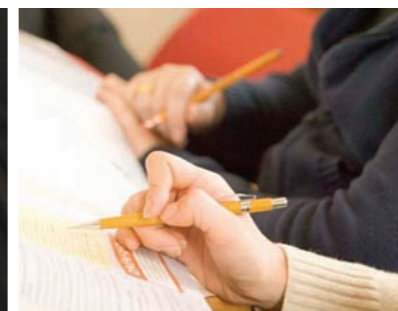
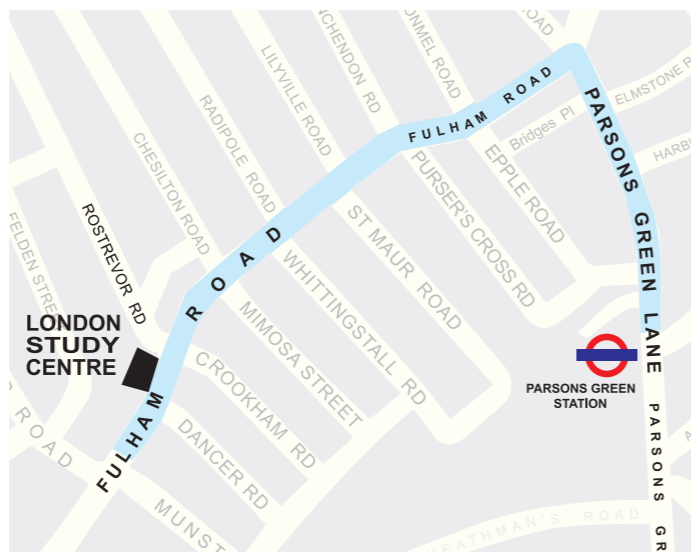

Course options

We offer a wide variety of English courses, which are summarized below:

- General English courses
- Business English courses
- Examination courses (Cambridge First Certificate, Cambridge Advanced, IELTS)
- Private tuition
- Conversation
- Pronunciation / Writing / Grammar

General/Business/Examination courses are for 15 hours per week. You can create individual course programs by combining courses so that you follow a more intensive program.

You can study for as little as two weeks and for as long as 48 weeks. For most courses, you can start your class on any Monday during term time.

Which course?

General English courses are for students who wish to improve their reading, writing, listening and speaking skills. These courses are an excellent first choice for new students.

Business English courses are for students who wish to use English in a business environment.

Examination courses are for students studying at Higher Intermediate level or above. University of Cambridge and IELTS examinations are internationally recognized.

Private tuition, conversation, pronunciation, writing and grammar classes are for students who wish to concentrate on specific aspects of their English skills.

You can create individual programs of 20, 25, 30 hours per week by combining General /Business/Exam courses with private tuition, conversation, pronunciation, writing and grammar courses.

Course levels

We have nine levels of English, from Basic Beginners to Advanced (more than most other schools) which means that we have exactly the right level for you to maximize your progress.

When you enrol with us, we will discuss the most appropriate level with you.

Sessions

You can choose one or more of the following session times:

Morning - 9am-12pm
Afternoon - 12pm-3pm, 3pm-6pm

Each three-hour session includes a twenty-five minute coffee break. During the break you can relax in the common room, in the garden, or on one of the patios. You can also purchase food and drink from our coffee shop.

Library

You can join our library, for a small additional fee, which will give you automatic access to extra study materials.

Social Events

We provide a varied social programme that enables you to visit tourist attractions both in and out of London and to learn about British history and society. We arrange cultural (museum, theatre, cinema, musicals) visits and sporting (football, table tennis) activities.

Accommodation

Our Accommodation Officer can help you find comfortable, affordable accommodation during your stay in London.
