Entry requirements

The DELTA is a University of Cambridge validated certificate. The entry requirements are:

Education The Diploma is a post-graduate qualification and candidates are usually university graduates or qualified teachers. The requirement is that candidates should have a standard of education equivalent to that required for entry into higher education and they will normally have undertaken some formal course of practical training at pre-service or in-service level.

Experience Applicants should have a minimum of two years (1,200 hours) teaching experience within the last five years. They will normally have a range of experience involving teaching different levels and in different contexts.

English Applicants must have an awareness of language and a competence in English, both written and spoken, that enables them to follow the course and complete all assessed elements.

Assessment

Candidates are assessed internally and externally. There are 3 components of assessment:

- **Course work:** seven assignments involving reading and research, essay writing, lesson planning, teaching and written self-evaluation plus two written assignments
- **Extended assignment:** an externally assessed case study
- **A written exam** (in June or December).
