RAMSGATE HOMESTAY JUNIORS: At Churchill House the well being of our Juniors (aged 15 and under) is particularly important. Juniors are always under the supervision of our staff whether in class or in activities and are placed in our more experienced families. We have a Junior Liaison Officer responsible for overall care and supervision. Tickets for excursions are sold to Juniors on the understanding that they will stay with our staff escort, group leader or other responsible adult at all times. After full day coach trips we arrange for students to leave the coach close to their families and after evening activities we ensure that students get home safely. Taxis are cheap and are arranged by our staff.

CHURCHILL HOUSE, RAMSGATE - Ages 12 to 70+

Courses take place in Churchill House's All Year Round school in the picturesque seaside town of Ramsgate. Less than 2 hours from London and close to some of Kent's most beautiful countryside and beaches. Host families are situated in Ramsgate and Birchington-on-Sea. All the facilities of a premier language school are available to students of all ages.

ALDENHAM SCHOOL, ELSTREE, HERTS – Residential (11-17 years)

Well positioned to the North West of Central London within the M25 with excellent connections to all major London airports. The school established in 1596 is set in over 110 acres of Hertfordshire countryside yet only 13 miles from Central London.

AMPLEFORTH SCHOOL, YORK – Residential (10-17 years)

Ampleforth College was established in 1802 and adjoins the Benedictine monastery and abbey in a stretch of magnificent Yorkshire countryside, close to York. The grounds extend to 2000 acres of outstanding natural beauty.

Trent College is located in beautiful grounds in the town of Long Eaton on the border of Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire. Founded in 1866, Trent has a rich heritage with traditions spanning 140 years. Only a short distance from Nottingham centre (8 miles) and with excellent road and rail links to London. Homestay families are all within walking distance of the college.

OTHER INFORMATION - RESIDENTIAL CENTRES

LESSON TIMES: 3 hours actual teaching per day, total 15 hours per week with morning lessons and afternoon sports and activities.

POCKET MONEY: Pocket money and personal expenditure may be included with payment for course fees or deposited with the Centre Manager on arrival and taken at weekly intervals although two days notice must be given when large amounts of pocket money are required. Students need only bring personal spending money - everything else is included.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE DAYS: Students should arrive and depart on Sundays or arrive and depart on Wednesdays as shown in the price list. Extra nights are possible by agreement.

INSURANCE: It is now a legal requirement to take out an insurance policy to cover students against travel and medical problems and cancellation or termination of the course. The school offers an insurance policy designed for students of English UK schools at £5 per week. Please ask for our information leaflet *Travel Insurance for Students Visiting the UK*.

OTHER INFORMATION - RAMSGATE HOMESTAY

LESSON TIMES: students have 3 hours actual teaching per day, total 15 hours per week in the morning or the afternoon.

INTENSIVE COURSES: Young Adults aged 16 & 17 arriving on 04/07 or 01/08 can have intensive courses of 20 hours or 25 hours per week with lessons in the morning and afternoon - for more information and prices please contact us.

ACTIVITIES: Courses in Ramsgate can be booked with an **Activity Programme** of daily sports/leisure and evening activities or with an **Activity Programme PLUS** that has the same sports and evening activities with the addition of an Excursion Programme of one weekend and one midweek coach excursion per week.

All Juniors must book an Activity Programme PLUS. All Young Adults (16 & 17 years) must book at least the Activity Programme. Extra full and half day excursions can be booked in advance or from the Social Club whilst in Ramsgate.

Multi-day Tours: European tours to Paris, Amsterdam and Belgium as well as extended British tours to the Lake District and Scotland can be booked in advance. Juniors need to be accompanied by a responsible adult and all Young Adults must obtain parents permission to be able to join the tours.

POCKET MONEY: Pocket money and personal expenditure may be included with payment for course fees and taken at weekly intervals. Students who have not booked full board will need approximately £30 per week (in addition to their personal spending money) for lunches. Allow £10 a week for taxis after evening activities plus the cost of any additional trips from the Social Club Programme.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE DAYS: Students should arrive on Sunday and depart on Saturday. Extra nights are possible by agreement.

ACCOMMODATION: Students share a room with a student of a different nationality although friends can request to share a room. Students staying with Birchington families are transported to and from the school by coach which is included in the price.

The Shared Transfer Service by Coach at all airports operates on arrival between 07:00 hrs and 19:00 hours (waiting time 0-3 hours) and on departure for flights leaving between 10.30 hours and 21.00 hours.

All students are met at the flight arrival gate on arrival. Children and juniors are supervised at all times.

Our Taxi Service is available on any arrival day at any time from any arrival point – airport, railway station, ferry port etc.

Juniors (aged 15 and under) must use our transfer service or be accompanied by a responsible adult aged 18 years or over. Young Adults (16 & 17 years) who chose to travel independently will be sent the train and coach information when booking a course.

The deposit of £150 must be paid when you book. It is also possible to make full payment at this stage. You can pay:

When we have received your enrolment form and £150 deposit we will reserve the course and accommodation for you and send you a Certificate of Enrolment confirming your course dates and the total price.

Please note: We must receive full payment for your course at least 21 days before you arrive.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I CANCEL?

- If you cancel your course because your visa application was refused we will refund 100% of fees paid on receipt of the original written visa refusal.
- If you cancel your course or accommodation *up to 21 days* before the start date, we will refund the total fees paid minus the deposit. If you cancel your course *less than 21 days* before the start date, the full value of all fees paid, minus the deposit, will be transferred to another course of your choice at a later date.
- If you wish to cancel all or part of your course or accommodation after your arrival 4 weeks' notice must be given. The balance of the accommodation fees will be refunded in full and the balance of the tuition fees will be transferred to another course at a later date. If less than the required notice period is given, 4 weeks' tuition and accommodation fees will still be deducted from the remaining balance.
