As soon as we receive your Enrollment Form, we will send confirmation of your acceptance in the course, along with an invoice detailing the payment due. We must receive your payment at least 30 days before your course begins.

Please note: If you are enrolling in a course that begins within 30 days, send the Enrolment Fee, and Programme Fee along with the Enrolment Form. If we refuse your application, all of these fees will be returned to you immediately.

Accommodation

Your accommodation is included in the Programme Fee as specified in the price boxes on pages 20-27. Students who choose to link courses for longer periods of study and wish to remain in their EF accommodation during any weeks without tuition will be subject to additional charges for accommodation-only weeks. Please note that these costs are not reflected in the course prices listed on pages 20-27, but can be confirmed by your local EF representative. In all countries accommodation is reserved from Sunday to Saturday (am), unless you are

informed otherwise.

Arrival and Airport Transfers

When you complete the Enrolment Form, you can indicate if you would like an EF representative to meet you at the nearest major airport to the school. The fee for this optional transfer from your airport of arrival is listed on the school pages 20-27. This covers the cost of administration, communication, greeting services and transportation. The transfer service is offered between 0700 and 2100 hours local time on Sundays. If you arrive at any other time we can arrange a special transfer for you, at a cost of £100. Please note a transfer from London to Manchester will cost £385.

Age

EF International Language Schools are open to everyone aged 16 years and over. Junior summer camps are for students aged 13-16 years old.

Duration of Lessons

EF language lessons have a duration of 40 minutes, except where stated otherwise on the individual location page.

Online One-to-One Package

This is a course supplement, available in combination with any EF Intensive or EF General course at our year-round English schools. The package includes six lessons of 45 minutes in length, which are conducted online. Students can choose to take the lessons while at the EF school or can also complete these lessons once returning home (using iLab user login). The initial package includes six lessons. A student can book an additional package as needed.

iLabs

iLabs are currently available at all EF International Schools of English. The second generation of the Efekt™ System will be rolled out in 2010 and will be available in all English schools. All EF General and Intensive courses include access to the iLab upon enrollment, throughout the course and 3 months post-course. For EF Intensive students on a course of 4 weeks or longer, a 6 month post-course (3 extra months) is included. To access the iLab from a private computer, the operating system must meet the following minimum hardware and software requirements: ▶ Computer type: PC ▶ Internet connection: 33.6 kbps or faster Internet connection. ▶ Processor speed (MHz), memory (RAM): Pentium 166+ MHz, 32+ MB of memory. A Pentium II, Pentium III, Pentium IV or Celeron processor is recommended. ▶ Sound card: Sound Blaster 16 compatible sound card or better (full-duplex). ▶ Audio components: Headset with microphone or separate microphone and speakers. ▶ Operating system: Windows 95 or higher. ▶ Web browser: Internet Explorer 5.5 (SP2) or higher. Recommended: Internet Explorer 6.0 with Service Pack 1 from Windows Updates.

Course Levels

A few weeks before you leave for your course, you will take the EF Level Placement Test online in iLab to assess your language level and ability. The results will be sent to your school to accurately place you in the correct level. On arrival you will be placed in the correct level at which you should begin your studies. Every EF school teaches the 6 levels of the Common European Framework. Please note: when a school has a beginners' group of less than five students, EF reserves the right to reduce the number of lessons per week.

Class schedules

In some schools classes may take place at the weekends, students will continue to have two consecutive days off. Classes are offered at all EF schools worldwide in a block schedule format, where students will have alternating morning and afternoon classes.

Public Holidays

In the event of a Public Holiday in your host country, EF schools will be closed, unless otherwise stated in the student pre-departure information, sent to you with your booking confirmation. Classes missed for Public Holidays will not be made up at a later date.

Cancellations and Refund Policy

All cancellations and terminations must be made in writing to your nearest EF office, EF local representative or EF School Director. In all cases the Enrolment Fee, the Courier Fee and the optional Cancellation Insurance premium are non-refundable.

Cancellations

The Programme prices shown with each school description in this brochure comprise two elements: the Course Fee (50%) for tuition and the Student Services Fee (50%), which includes accommodation. The Course Fee is fully refundable if you cancel prior to arrival at the school.

Additional refunds will be made from the Student Services Fee as follows:

- If you cancel 45 days or more before the start of the course you will receive a full refund, except for the Enrolment Fee, the Courier Fee, and the Programme Deposit. The Programme Deposit will be refunded if your visa application is denied
- If you cancel less than 45 days prior to departure, EF will retain 40% of the Student Services and Accommodation (maximum £500) to cover the cost of pre-paid accommodation and services.

In the event that the World Health Organization (WHO), or an international governmental health authority issues a country-specific travel warning or forbids travel, EF students have the right to postpone or re-book travel within a period of 365 days. If students wish to cancel, the above stated cancellation stipulations apply.

Withdrawals

If you wish to withdraw from your course after arrival at the school, you must give the EF School Director at least four (4) weeks advance notice. You will receive a full refund for all remaining weeks after the four week notice period.

Refunds can only be made by the EF office or representative where the course fees were paid. The EF office or representative will process all refunds within 30 days of receiving written notification from you. These conditions do not affect your rights as defined by the consumer protection laws in your host country.

Note: there is a separate Refund Policy for the Academic Year Abroad and Multi-Language Year Programmes. Students applying for these programmes will be sent an enrolment pack with full information.

Travel Insurance

All participants traveling to the USA, Canada, New Zealand and Australia are required to have medical and accident insurance. We strongly recommend that students attending any of our other schools, including those in Europe, take similar precautions. We have negotiated favourable premiums and a tailor-made coverage for EF students with an international insurance company expert in travel insurance. The policy protects you against expenses incurred through accident or illness, and provides coverage for loss or theft of baggage and personal effects. It also provides coverage against interruption of your EF programme due to illness as well as Liability. The cost of this insurance is £30 for the first two weeks, then £10 for each additional week. If you do not wish to take this policy, please indicate so on the Enrolment Form, and provide us with a copy in English of the alternative insurance policy you have taken out individually.

Re-booking Fee

Each time you request a change of course town, course dates, or type of accommodation after your initial enrolment, EF will charge you a re-booking fee of £35 which is payable immediately. (This does not apply to students who are extending or upgrading their course.)

There are separate charges for changing course town. For academic year students please contact your EF representative for details.

Late Arrivals and Absences

If you arrive late to a course, or are absent during your course, no refund will be granted. Periods of absence may not be made up with free extension of the course. EF will consider, at its discretion, a partial refund in cases where there is evidential proof of exceptional and extenuating circumstances. For non EU students, EF complies with the UK immigration laws regarding periods of absence.

Protection for Our Customers

EF provides complete financial protection for customers, formalised according to EC directives, through an insurance policy that guarantees your money back, and your repatriation in the event of the company's failure.

Liability

EF will not be liable in any way to the student in the event of any service, contracted to be supplied by EF, becoming impossible to supply by reason of industrial dispute or other cause outside the control of EF. 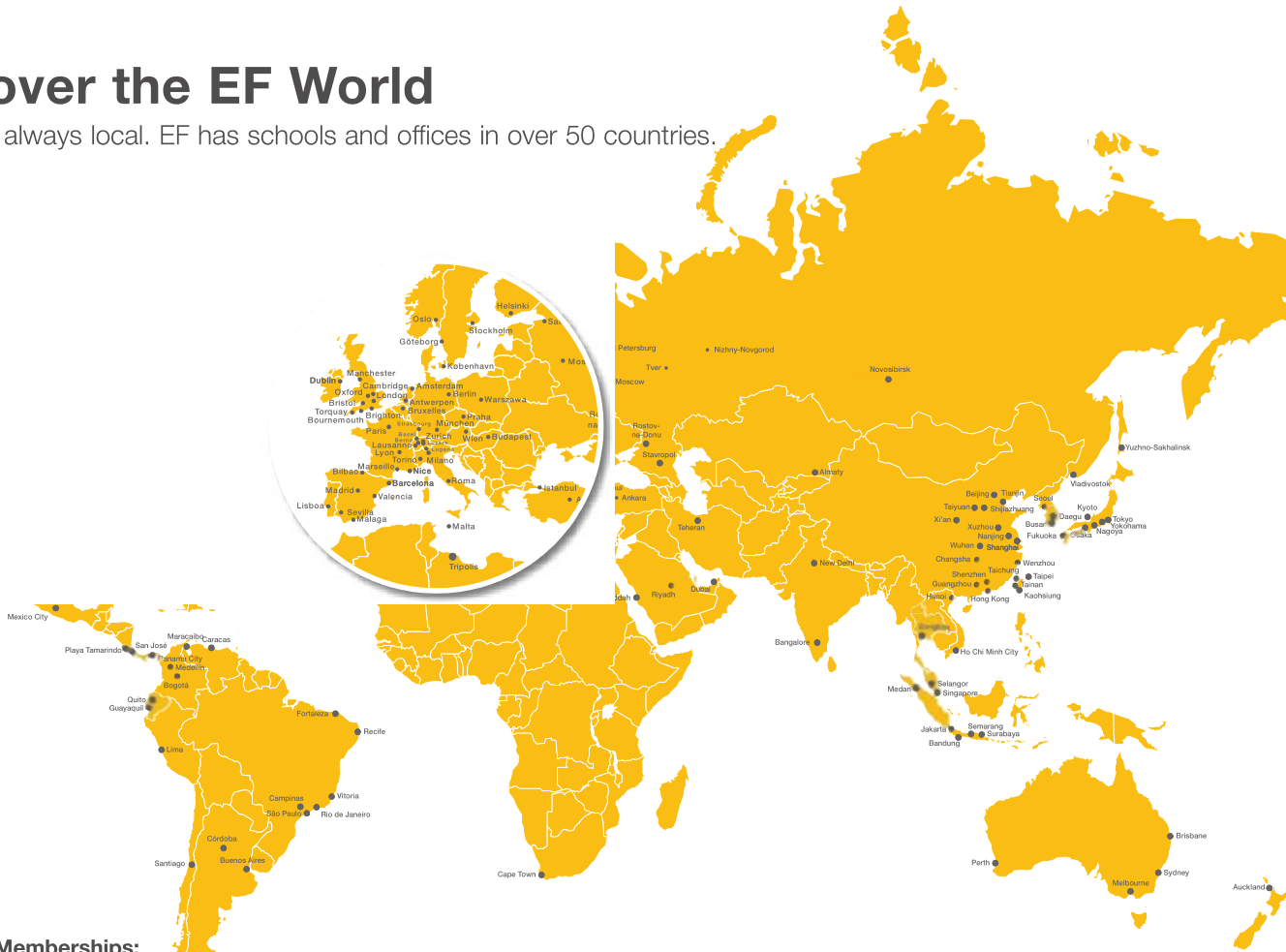
