

A day in the life

What really happens at LSC Summer!

"There is no time to get bored! Every day we are doing new and different things!

Time to get up

I wake up quite early and go to breakfast with other students between 0730-0830 in the dining room. The food is good: there are bread rolls, slices of cheese and cold meat, cereal, fruit and drinks like coffee, tea or fruit juices. The English call this a "Continental Breakfast"! Then they make me go back to my room to tidy. I don't like this, but I have to do it!

In class

We have English lessons with our teacher in the classrooms. They start at 0900 and finish at 1245. We have lessons of 45 minutes and then we have a break for 15 minutes. The lessons are good and the teacher is fun. We practise all of the main areas of English: speaking, listening, reading and writing, and we play games and work in small groups, so the lessons are quite varied. The teacher makes sure that we are having fun as she says this is the best way for us to learn.

I'm hungry!

Lunch is in the dining room, with a main meal and a dessert. When we go on trips, like to London or Harry Potter, we get a packed lunch to take with us.

Time to have some fun

Then, in the afternoon, we do activities or excursions. When we do activities, we play outdoor games like football, tennis, netball, rounders, even tag rugby and cricket, and we also go to the sports hall to play things like basketball and badminton. There is always a LSC leader who goes with us to do the activities. When we do excursions, we travel by train or bus and go to see the attractions. Sometimes we go on guided walks around London, which are really good because you can see lots of different famous places. London is really big!

I'm hungry again!

We come back and have dinner in the dining room at around 1800. We have a main meal and a dessert, and then we go and do more indoor activities like film nights, discos, karaoke and on the last day we have a camp fire with our LSC leader."



London Fulham

Location

Our London summer school is based at our school in Fulham in the heart of London. Fulham is a fashionable area around 20 minutes from the centre of London. Nearby are Chelsea and Fulham FC and the River Thames.

Facilities

Our school is in an historic building with spacious classrooms, wifi access throughout the building, TV, tuck shop serving drinks and snacks, and indoor and outdoor social areas to relax in.

Accommodation

We offer several accommodation options: Students can choose to stay in full board homestay accommodation in twin or triple rooms or in our new student residence in single or twin rooms. Alternatively, students may arrange their own accommodation (e.g. with family members that live in London).

Activities & Excursions

London Fulham is the perfect base to explore London and also offers students the chance to visit attractions outside London, like Oxford and Cambridge. We offer a full programme of activities in the London area, plus half-day and full-day excursions to places of interest both inside and outside London. All activities and excursions are supervised by a qualified member of LSC staff. Students travel to and from activities and excursions by bus, coach or train.

Chalfont St. Giles

Location

Chalfont St. Giles is a picturesque village 40km west of London. The LSC campus is located in Newlands Park and was the campus of the University of Buckinghamshire. It has over 180 acres of outside space!

Facilities

The campus provides residential and academic facilities, including well-equipped classrooms, lecture theatres, and excellent recreational areas. The campus provides social areas including a dance studio and disco room. Sports are well catered for with a wide selection of outdoor sports areas including outdoor football and rugby pitches.

Accommodation

The accommodation has recently been refurbished. Students stay in a single bedroom with a wash basin. Bathrooms are shared by apartment (1:4 ratio). Linen is provided and bedrooms are cleaned.

Activities & Excursions

London Chalfont is the perfect base to enjoy on-site activities using the fantastic indoor and outdoor activities, and also to discover London during full-day excursions to places of interest. Students will travel into London by local train and will receive a travelcard. The on-site activity programme includes discos, quizzes, sports tournaments and games nights. The excursions include visits to world famous places like Oxford, Cambridge, Hampton Court, Windsor Castle, and tourist attractions such as the nearby Harry Potter studios!

Location

Our Kingston summer school is based at the wellknown Tiffin Girls School in Kingston-upon-Thames, an affluent and fashionable riverside suburb in south west London. 
