

Our classes take place in Bloomsbury Square, a few metres down the road from the British Museum in the heart of London. Students will receive a certificate and a course report at the end of their stay.

Accommodation

Our new hall of residence is situated within easy walking distance of our school. The address is 95-97 Gower Street. All our students will have access to some of the common areas such as TV room, music room, games room and great social activities. There is a garden too where students can hang out in their free time. Rooms: These are single, twins and triples. There will be floors reserved for girls and floors reserved for boys. Each floor is equipped with shower areas and toilets, designated for girls and boys separately (each toilet/shower is shared by 4 students) as well as an extra toilet on each floor. We will provide towels and bed sheets which will be changed once a week. Each room is furnished with desks, wardrobes, a wash basin and has free Wi-Fi internet access. We also provide a same day laundry service once a week at no extra charge. Trained and caring YES leaders will also be staying in the residence available 24 hours a day...

The Canteen: we serve 3 hot meals daily in the residence canteen. For each meal there will be 3 or 4 options, one of which is vegetarian. Last year our students loved the Full English Breakfast and the Fish and Chips!!! A packed lunch is provided on Saturdays only as the group will be spending the day out of London (see social programme). Dinner will be provided as usual.

Social Programme

Flexible Programme: we offer you a variety of options to ensure that each student creates a course that best fits their time and budget.

Exam Preparation: we offer an excellent exam preparation programme for students, whether they are looking to prepare for the Cambridge or IELTS exams.

General English: the General English lessons are imaginative and structured to allow maximum time to learn and practise new language.

Students will build their English vocabulary and learn colloquial English, idioms and grammar to help them become as fluent as possible. We use interesting textbooks, videos, games and group activities to share and practise how English is used by native English speakers every day.

Students are able to choose the number of hours per week during which they have classes: 15, 20, 25 or 30 hours a week.

General English 20: students will attend a 3 hour class and 1 extra hour of Conversation where the main focus is on Fluency and Pronunciation.

Intensive English 25: students will attend a 3 hour class and choose two 1 hour classes from either Conversation, Writing or Grammar.

Intensive English 30: students will attend a 3 hour class plus 1 hour each of Conversation, Writing and Grammar.
Or 2 x 3 hour classes.

Information

Some questions

How much English do I need to know to be able to apply to come on one of your courses? We need you to have an elementary level of English. We will send you an electronic placement test and you will know which class you will be in before you arrive.

How much should I bring to spend in London? I hear it is expensive! You need to allow around £2 per day for your daily ticket to travel around London. If you are attending our Young Learner Summer School then £50 will be enough for a few treats.

Are the children supervised at all times? We have a trained first aid officer with the students while in class and during excursions. Risk assessments are carefully carried out according to British Council guidelines. As well as a 24 hour emergency number, there will be a telephone number for your group leader in the welcome pack you will get once your place on the course has been confirmed. It also has the details of where you will be staying. Your parents will therefore have a number of ways to contact you in an emergency. Emergency telephone number: +44 (0) 7435971250

Will I have access to the internet? Yes, there are computers at the school for you to use. You can use them during your breaks to access the internet for free.

Are the children supervised at all time? Yes they are. We take very good care of all under 18s there are 10 members of staff who are trained and responsible for looking after under 18s.
