
# the original resort



# a friendly town

Scarborough has been the destination of choice for tourists since the 17th Century. It is the largest holiday resort on the Yorkshire coast, where a warm welcome meets every visitor. It has everything that is expected of an established seaside town which is rich in history, culture and charm, plus breathtaking countryside, offering peace and relaxation.

Annual festivals in Scarborough provide excellent opportunities for international visitors to make English friends easily. These include Seafest, International Jazz, Scarborough Fayre, Beached (outdoor music concerts) and the Cricket festival.











# great choice

Scarborough provides a wide range of entertainment for people of all ages, such as the Sea Life Centre, Scarborough Art Gallery and the unique Spa Complex. The two main beaches provide a great source of enjoyment - the South Bay, with its fishing harbour, marina, cafes, and amusement arcades; the North Bay with its watersports and close-by parks. Both bays are separated by the magnificent medieval Scarborough Castle.

The resort also provides a great choice of high street shops and boutiques, as well as an indoor shopping centre. The pedestrianised town centre also boasts inviting cafes and bars.



# lively nightlife

With many traditional Yorkshire pubs offering live music, four nightclubs, two cinemas, several theatres staging concerts, ballets and summer shows, a casino and a wide range of restaurants and bars, it is easy to find something to do during the evenings.

Scarborough is also home to the famous

Stephen Joseph Theatre which hosts original plays by resident playwright Sir Alan

Aykbourne, before reaching London's West End.







# cutting-edge technology

Anglolang has a modern approach to teaching, for example, most classrooms are equipped with interactive whiteboards. These touch sensitive whiteboards increase student interaction and make lessons more dynamic. Teachers also uses digital software for English language learning. These modern teaching methods make learning highly enjoyable.

# flexible course structure

Anglolang's teachers consult their students and then tailor lessons to meet their needs. This is known as the 'negotiated syllabus' which gives students flexibility and choice. A variety of up-to-date and motivating teaching materials are used, for example, DVDs, CDs, newspapers, TV, course books and authentic texts.

# topic-based lessons

Lessons are based around topics, such as work, travel or current affairs. Topics are chosen in consultation with students as part of the 'negotiated syllabus'.

# skills areas

Teachers also focus on developing speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. Speaking, for example, is improved through discussion, role-play, mini-presentations and pronunciation activities. Students are helped

to read faster and enrich their vocabulary through authentic texts. Writing for communicative purposes, such as letters, reports and essays, is often practised as homework.


### grammar

Grammatical structures are introduced and reviewed according to the needs of students when negotiating the syllabus.

# vocabulary development

Vocabulary is a very important part of all lessons at Anglolang. Teachers give advice on how to effectively record, learn and activate vocabulary.









# communicate with confidence

Communicative teaching methods are used to develop the skills needed to communicate in English with confidence. As well as increasing confidence when using English, teachers also focus on increasing fluency and accuracy.

# course **options**

There are two course options:-

4 hours tuition per day
 09.00 - 13.00 (incl. breaks)

or

7 hours tuition per day
 09.00 - 17.00 (incl. breaks)

### small class sizes

During the non-Summer months (from September to mid-June) there is a maximum number of 8 students per class, depending on which course is booked. During Summer (mid-June to August), there can be a maximum of 15 students per class.

### level

There are 6 group levels. These are

Elementary, Lower Intermediate, Intermediate, Higher Intermediate, Advanced and Proficiency. It is recommended that complete beginners have one-to-one tuition before joining a group. All students complete a placement test before arriving at the school. Pre-testing allows students to begin lessons at 09.00 on the first day of arrival, to maximise learning time.

# intercultural training

Anglolang offers a specialist language and intercultural training course called Developing Intercultural Competence in a European Context. This course improves English and increases awareness of cultural diversity while developing skills for communicating and working successfully with people who come from a range of cultural backgrounds. The course develops practical strategies for avoiding intercultural misunderstandings. It is a combination of I week of training at Anglolang and 4 weeks of online learning and language development.

# individual needs


Before arriving at Anglolang, a needs analysis questionnaire is completed for private tuition, as well as the Anglolang placement test. During the first lesson, a more detailed needs analysis takes place and consultation continues throughout the course. This allows the teachers to plan an individualised learning programme.

# course materials

When planning a one-to-one course, personal background, learning experience and individual learning styles are considered. In lessons, authentic materials such as newspaper articles, the Internet, company reports and TV recordings can be used. It is also possible to arrange a study visit, if desired.

# home tuition

For a highly intensive course, it is possible to live and study in an English teacher's home. This provides a unique programme with all the benefits of private tuition as well as a rich cultural experience. The teacher will include the student in the social life of the family and encourage the student to mix with the local community.









# maximum flexibility

Anglolang's teachers have extensive experience in preparing students for English examinations. The school is a Cambridge examination centre and a TOEIC test centre. Examination courses offer maximum flexibility because they can be joined for a full academic year or just a few weeks.

# practical classroom ideas

# pre-course e-learning

Each course consists of 4 weeks of e-learning before 2 weeks of training at Anglolang. The e-learning allows participants to increase their confidence when using English, to network with other teachers via a message board and to receive language feedback from a personal trainer at Anglolang.

# language development

Both courses include English language development classes which involve advanced discussion aimed at improving oral fluency, listening skills and vocabulary range.

# classroom methodology

The methodology training focuses on interactive, communicative classroom activities. Training sessions can include:

- · Vocabulary learning
- Computer Assisted Language Learning
- Motivating learners to speak
- · Literature in the classroom
- · Exploiting authentic materials

# study visits

Teachers' courses also include a visit to a local school or college during term time. During the summer holidays (mid-June to the end of August), all teachers' courses include one full day Wednesday excursion to a place of cultural interest.

# championship golf course

Scarborough has two first-class golf courses, and there are several others close to Scarborough, including the famous Ganton championship golf course. North Cliff Golf Course has a cliff top start and finish, with stunning views of both the North Bay and Scarborough Castle. Similarly South Cliff Golf Course has coastal views. With little rough and few trees, the greens are well shaped to provide a challenge.

In co-operation with Scarborough's golf clubs, Anglolang offers the opportunity to improve English and play golf. English is practised in the morning and then golf can be played in the afternoon. Professional golf coaching can also be organised.

# experienced golfer

For golfers with an official handicap, the course includes:

- 5 green fees (which can be exchanged for private coaching sessions)

Anglolang's exciting Summer Vacation Course combines motivating English classes with fun cultural and sporting activities. Each week includes:



# guest house (B&B)


