Students who would like to have a more independent stay and meet people of other nationalities outside the school might choose this type of accommodation. The residences are all located in zone 1 (city centre) or zone 2 with easy transportation to the school. Depending on the residence, you can choose a single or a twin room or even a studio. Some residences have basic facilities (shared bathroom and kitchen), others offer en-suite rooms and meals.
