General English Courses

Year-round courses

- from 2 to 48 weeks
- Pre-intermediate to Advanced

General English classes are from Monday to Friday.

Important: Internexus does not have provision for English Language students who are beginners.

Intensive: 27 hours per week: 9.15am-4.45pm

Our most popular course: Students combine a three-hour class of General English with two specific afternoon classes (options). The three hour class is a balanced, communicative class covering the skills of speaking, listening, writing and reading. These classes also focus on pronunciation, grammar, vocabulary, and aspects of British culture and life in Britain. The afternoon classes have a specific focus and these may change every two weeks, for example; conversation classes, writing skills, Academic English, Business English. The afternoon classes run from Monday - Thursday and on Friday there is a workshop.

Semi-Intensive: 15 hours per week - Mornings: 9.15am-12.30pm

15 hours per week - Afternoons: 1.30-4.45pm

The afternoon classes consist of two option classes with a Friday afternoon workshop

Students can either study in the morning or the afternoon.

The minimum age for all courses at Internexus London is 16. There is a maximum of 15 students per class with an average of 10-12 students per class.

Internship Programmes

Students first take a full-time English course followed by a full-time unpaid work placement. Work placements are allocated on arrival and can be arranged in almost any sector: administration, finance, marketing, engineering, etc.* Students are able to improve their English and gain important international work experience. Certificates are given from both the English course and the placement. Students from outside the EU must enter the UK on a General Student Visa to do this programme. Required level is upper intermediate to advanced.

Internexus can arrange for visa national students to take 'Workskills Plus', a qualification at NVQ level 3 (provided by Edexcel additional fee incurred)

Please read all the information below carefully.

Cancellation and Refund Policy for all programmes

Before classes begin: The course deposit (£150) and housing application fee (£50) are non-refundable. All other fees must be paid two weeks prior to course start date. Fees paid are refundable if you cancel two weeks prior to the beginning of the course (with the exception of course deposit and housing application fee).

Accommodation: You may change or cancel your homestay/private home with two week's notice only with bookings of more than 4 weeks. Students who wish to cancel accommodation in student residences will be charged the cancellation rates of the residence. Ask the school for details.

Refunds will be sent to the student or guardian normally within thirty (30) days. Post and bank fees will be deducted if applicable. No refunds will be given once the course has started.

Enrolment Agreement

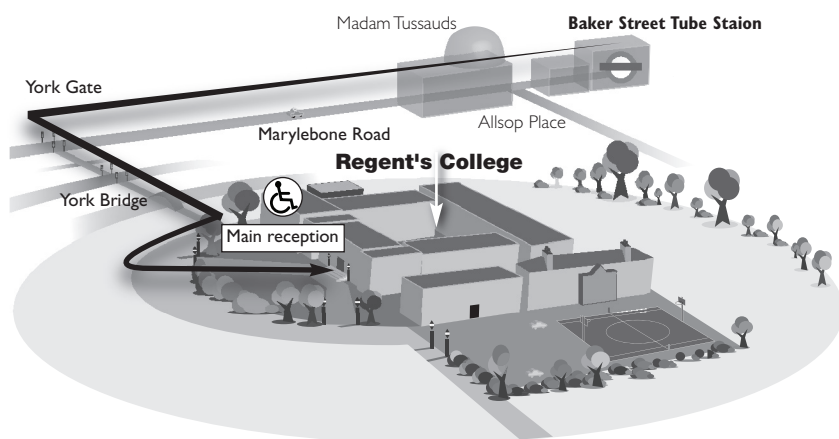

College:

The college and residence are situated inside Regent's Park, zone 1 in central London. Nearby is Regent's Canal and some of the finest Georgian architecture in London. Only a short distance from the centre of London, and with Baker Street and Marylebone only a 5-minute walk away, the campus is a perfect place for student life with all of London's great cultural and social attractions at your disposal. The campus also houses a large Library, an Information Technology centre with free internet and wireless, Language Laboratory as well as a restaurant, bar, and state-of-the-art sports gym (free for summer students), football 5-a-side, a tennis court and other student facilities.



Residence:

Reid Hall is the stately north wing of Regent's College and looks out over the lake and surrounding park. It provides on-campus accommodation minutes from all the College amenities.

The hall of residence houses 210 students in single, twin and triple rooms.

- All rooms have a bed, night stand, wardrobe, desks, chairs and study lamps.
- Twin rooms are furnished with 2 beds (usually bunk beds).
- Fresh linen is provided every two weeks.
- A pantry (kettle, sink and microwave) is available on each floor.
- A coin-operated laundrette is situated in Reid Hall.
- Single sex bathrooms are located in the corridors of each floor.
- WIFI internet access is available in the lobby of Reid Hall and in most rooms.
- A college representative is on duty at the front desk 24 hours a day.
- Students have swipe card access to the building and get a key to their individual room.
- A member of the Student Services team also lives in the Hall.
